

State Fair Spectacular Horse Sale

Terms & Conditions

- 1) Buyers and spectators are cautioned to be careful while on the grounds particularly while horses are being shown or sold in the sale ring. All persons attending the sale do so at their own risk. Neither the owners (agents) nor any other person connected with State Fair Spectacular Horse Sale assume any liability legal or otherwise, for accidents to persons or property, before, during or after the sale.
- 2) Be sure to inspect any horse(s) of interest to your satisfaction before you buy. A Veterinarian will be available prior to sale time to answer questions.
- 3) All horses entering the sale ring will be sold to the highest bidder, If a dispute arises between or among two or more bidders, sole authority to settle the dispute as he sees fit is reserved by the auctioneer and the decisions shall be final.
- 4) All persons planning on purchasing horses in this sale must have a Driver's license, Address and current letter of credit on file to receive a bidding number.
- 5) Writing an insufficient funds check for a horse purchase is classified as a felony and it will be turned over to the Hall County Attorney for prosecution and immediate legal action will be taken.
- 6) All horses listed in the catalog are guaranteed sound by the owner (Agent). The guarantee is strictly by the owner (Agent) and not the sale management. Right to recourse must be directly to the owner (seller) and not through State Fair Spectacular Horse sale management. State Fair Spectacular Horse Sale only act as agents for the consigners in the sale. Soundness to include sight out of both eyes, not to crib or be cryptorchid, soundness on all four legs and good air.
- 7) State Fair Spectacular Horse Sale WILL NOT allow private Horse Trading in the Yards, Alleys or in the Premises before, during, or after the sale. Any offender to the policy will be banned from the premises. All persons selling NO SALE Horses on the premises after they leave the ring must pay full commission in the office. Feel free to call any of the agents about their horses or any of the Management of the State Fair Spectacular Horse Sale.
- 8) The following will be required at the time before the Sale 1). General Health check by a Veterinarian- current health certificate (30 day) must be provided. 2). Negative Coggins Test within 6 months of sale date, 3) Original Registration Papers if the horse is registered. A signed Transfer must also be with the Registration Papers.
- 9) All Consignors are responsible to read the cataloged information on their horse(s). If any information is incorrect, the consignor is responsible to announce any necessary corrections at sale time.
